Student Duties: CFRW interns help support the mission of the Cape Fear River Watch through a variety of tasks. Interns assist with:

- Water quality projects, including field monitoring, lab work, and litter clean-ups
- Environmental education programming, including field and class presentations, community education events, and guided ecotours
- Outreach, tabling events and engaging with the community around the area
- Data entry and miscellaneous administrative, non-profit tasks
- Creating content for our e-newsletter and social media channels
- Operations at the Greenfield Lake Boathouse, as needed

Qualifications (General):

- Strong work ethic, and ability to take initiative and be a self-starter
- Flexibility and adaptability, especially regarding duties and schedule
- Strong written and oral communication skills and interpersonal skills
- Experience working with children and/or the public
- Positive attitude and enthusiasm for environmental conservation efforts and field work, especially in harsh field conditions (high heat and humidity)
- Strong organization skills
- Physically able to lift 50 lbs (kayaks and canoes)
